## Thoughts from the Kitchen

Gone are the days when I used to slave over a hot stove to produce Cordon very pale Bleu meals. I now depend on quick and simple 'From the store cupboard' recipes so that I can spend more time on idle pursuits. However these two are good standbys when emergencies arise. You will note that I've not gone decimal – evidence of age!

### Tuna Quiche (Serves 6)

8oz shortcrust pastry (Frozen?)  
4 oz cheddar cheese – grated  
1 tin of tuna chunks (185g) – drained  
5 fluid oz milk

3 eggs

Seasoning

Turn oven to gas 6/200C/400F

Line an 8in loose based flan tin with pastry.

Spread the tuna & grated cheese evenly over the base

Whisk eggs and milk together with seasoning and pour over the filling.

Bake immediately for 10 minutes at 200C and a further 40 mins

at gas 4/180C/350F

Allow to cool; serve with a mixed salad

## Email Forums and Neighbourhood Watch

### Join the email forum and keep up to date with local affairs.

An email forum is a list of email addresses held on the Internet. Anyone on the list can send a message to a simple email address, e.g. [sandonparish@yahoo.com](mailto:sandonparish@yahoo.com) and that message will be distributed to everyone on the list. The forum is a very handy way of keeping the community informed of developments and has proved very useful on a number of occasions. It is also a good platform for making your views known or for reporting on something that should be generally known. All Sandon parish councilors are members of the Sandon email forum so you can make your views known to them and they in turn can keep you informed.

### Have you lost a cat or want to sell something? Advertise through the forum!

Sandon Neighbourhood watch operates through the forum. It is an ideal medium for this application. Members receive a heads up on any crime reported in the area. Conversely, forum members can report any suspicious activity that they spot. There are local Police Community Support Officers on the forum so they will pick up any alerts raised by residents. (Of course, any serious law-breaking should still be reported directly by telephone - 999 for urgent matters or 0300 333 4444 for non-urgent cases.)

There are two email forums in the parish: one for Sandon parish as a whole and another for Howe Green residents only. Neighbourhood watch alerts go to both forums.

### Our aim is to get everyone in the parish who has Internet access on one of these forums.

Joining a forum is easy. Just email your details to [david@pearson7.plus.com](mailto:david@pearson7.plus.com). (Leaving is also easy, if you change your mind.)

Once registered, you will receive all emails sent to the forum (on average around seven in a week). Sending a message to a forum is easy: either Reply to a forum message or send your email to:

[hgca@yahoo.com](mailto:hgca@yahoo.com) for the Howe Green forum, as appropriate.

The forums are private. Only residents who are registered with a forum can send messages to that forum. Therefore, no spam comes from the forums.
