For 5 minutes before a service  
begins let us all try to stop  
talking and keep a time of  
prayerful quiet as we all  
prepare to worship our Lord  
Jesus Christ.

### **COLLECT (12<sup>th</sup> Sunday)**

Almighty and everlasting God,  
you are always more ready to hear  
than we to pray  
and to give more than either we  
desire or deserve:  
pour down upon us the abundance  
of your mercy,  
forgiving us those things of which  
our conscience is afraid  
and giving us those good things  
which we are not worthy to ask  
but through the merits and  
mediation  
of Jesus Christ your Son our Lord,  
who is alive and reigns with you,  
in the unity of the Holy Spirit,  
one God, now and for ever.

### **COLLECT (Patronal)**

Almighty and everlasting God,  
who stooped to raise fallen  
humanity  
through the child-bearing of

blessed Mary:  
grant that we, who have seen your  
glory

revealed in our human nature  
and your love made perfect in our  
weakness,  
may daily be renewed in your  
image  
and conformed to the pattern of  
your Son,  
Jesus Christ our Lord,  
who is alive and reigns with you,  
in the unity of the Holy Spirit,  
one God, now and for ever.

#### FIRST READING

**Colossians 3.12-17**

12 As God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience. 13 Bear with one another and, if anyone has a complaint against another, forgive each other; just as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive. 14 Above all, clothe yourselves with love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony. 15 And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in the one body. And be thankful. 16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly; teach and admonish one another in all wisdom; and with gratitude in your hearts sing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs to God. 17 And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the

Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.

#### THE GOSPEL

**Luke 6.27-38**

27 'But I say to you that listen, Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, 28 bless those who curse you, pray for those who abuse you. 29 If anyone strikes you on the cheek, offer the other also; and from anyone who takes away your coat do not withhold even your shirt. 30 Give to everyone who begs from you; and if anyone takes away your goods, do not ask for them again. 31 Do to others as you would have them do to you.

32 'If you love those who love you, what credit is that to you? For even sinners love those who love them. 33 If you do good to those who do good to you, what credit is that to you? For even sinners do the same. 34 If you lend to those from whom you hope to receive, what credit is that to you? Even sinners lend to sinners, to receive as much again. 35 But love your enemies, do good, and lend, expecting nothing in return. Your reward will be great, and you will be children of the Most High; for he is kind to the ungrateful and the wicked. 36 Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful.

37 'Do not judge, and you will not be judged; do not condemn, and you will not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven;

38 give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together, running over, will be put into your lap; for the measure you give will be the measure you get back.'

#### Post Communion Prayer

God most high,  
whose handmaid bore the Word  
made flesh:

we thank you that in this  
sacrament of our redemption  
you visit us with your Holy Spirit  
and overshadow us by your  
power;

strengthen us to walk with Mary  
the joyful path of obedience  
and so to bring forth the fruits of  
holiness;  
through Jesus Christ our Lord.
