COLLECT for Harvest Thanksgiving

Eternal God,
you crown the year with your
goodness
and you give us the fruits of the
earth in their season:
grant that we may use them to
your glory,
for the relief of those in need
and for our own well-being;
through Jesus Christ your Son
our Lord,
who is alive and reigns with
you,
in the unity of the Holy Spirit,
one God, now and for ever.

FIRST READING

Philippians 4.4-9

4 Rejoice in the Lord always;
again I will say, Rejoice. ⁵Let
your gentleness be known to
everyone. The Lord is near. ⁶Do
not worry about anything, but
in everything by prayer and
supplication with thanksgiving
let your requests be made
known to God. ⁷And the peace
of God, which surpasses all
understanding, will guard your
hearts and your minds in Christ
Jesus.

8 Finally, beloved, whatever is
true, whatever is honourable,
whatever is just, whatever is
pure, whatever is pleasing,
whatever is commendable, if

there is any excellence and if
there is anything worthy of
praise, think about these things.
⁹Keep on doing the things that
you have learned and received
and heard and seen in me, and
the God of peace will be with
you.

THE GOSPEL

John 6.25-35

25 When they found him on the
other side of the lake, they said
to him, 'Rabbi, when did you
come here?' ²⁶Jesus answered
them, 'Very truly, I tell you, you
are looking for me, not because
you saw signs, but because you
ate your fill of the loaves. ²⁷Do
not work for the food that
perishes, but for the food that
endures for eternal life, which
the Son of Man will give you.
For it is on him that God the
Father has set his seal.' ²⁸Then
they said to him, 'What must we
do to perform the works of
God?' ²⁹Jesus answered them,
'This is the work of God, that
you believe in him whom he has
sent.' ³⁰So they said to him,
'What sign are you going to give
us then, so that we may see it
and believe you? What work
are you performing?' ³¹Our
ancestors ate the manna in the
wilderness; as it is written, "He
gave them bread from heaven

to eat." ' ³²Then Jesus said to
them, 'Very truly, I tell you, it
was not Moses who gave you
the bread from heaven, but it is
my Father who gives you the
true bread from heaven. ³³For
the bread of God is that which
comes down from heaven and
gives life to the world.' ³⁴They
said to him, 'Sir, give us this
bread always.'

35 Jesus said to them, 'I am the
bread of life. Whoever comes to
me will never be hungry, and
whoever believes in me will
never be thirsty
