

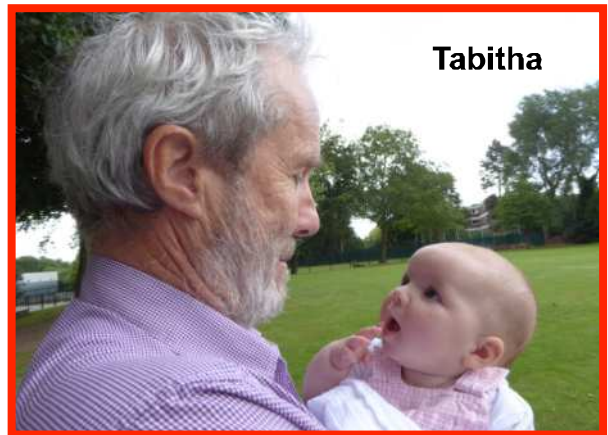


Bear on his 3rd Birthday

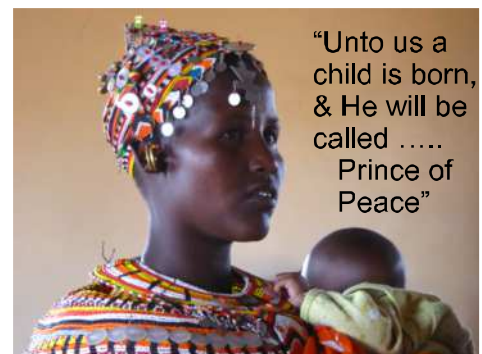
