## NOTES ON CHURCH

The thick south wall of the nave was built c1080. The walls of the nave and chancel are of pudding stone and flint, traces of Roman brick used for the corners, mark the successive easterly extensions of the church. Only one hammer beam roof truss is all that remains of the six that formed the 15th century oak ceiling replaced in 1878.

The chancel arch has undergone several alterations. It was originally the east wall of the Norman church. It was widened when the east wall was demolished and the chancel extended eastward by about four feet in c1450.

The porch is Tudor brick with a vaulted roof, and was built at the same time as the massive tower in 1520. They were added by Cardinal Wolsey, Lord of the Manor of Sandon Hall [died 1530]. The tower top has the appearance of the Cardinal's hat, its strings being represented by darker bricks. The dome is actually the sounding chamber for the bells and the dark bricks form a series of crosses to match the St Andrew's crosses further down. The porch was restored in 1963 in memory of the Rector's Warden. (See no. 57)

The stone font is c1550 with the wooden cover given in 1935 in memory of the Incumbent's wife, G.L. Williams. (See inscription C38 within the church)

The meeting room with kitchen and toilet facilities were added in 1993.

Extracts taken from the church guide.

Lynton Lamb, a local artist whose pictures can be seen within the church, is buried in the churchyard along with his wife Bidy. (See no. 41)

The church overlooks the village green, where on Thursday 31st March 1887, a Spanish oak tree was planted to celebrate the Queen's Jubilee. Mrs. S.T. Gibson, wife of the Rector, carried out the planting. The village blacksmith, Mr. Stibbard, created an iron seat surrounding the tree. He made it giving as was thought room for expansion, but the tree grew more rapidly than expected and the seat had to be expanded. The magnificent tree was cut down and removed in June 2001 having succumbed to fungal disease. In March 2002, another Queen's Jubilee year, three English oaks were planted to fill the void on the green.

The Howe Green United Reformed Church was erected in 1873 in brick, replacing another building resembling a shed.

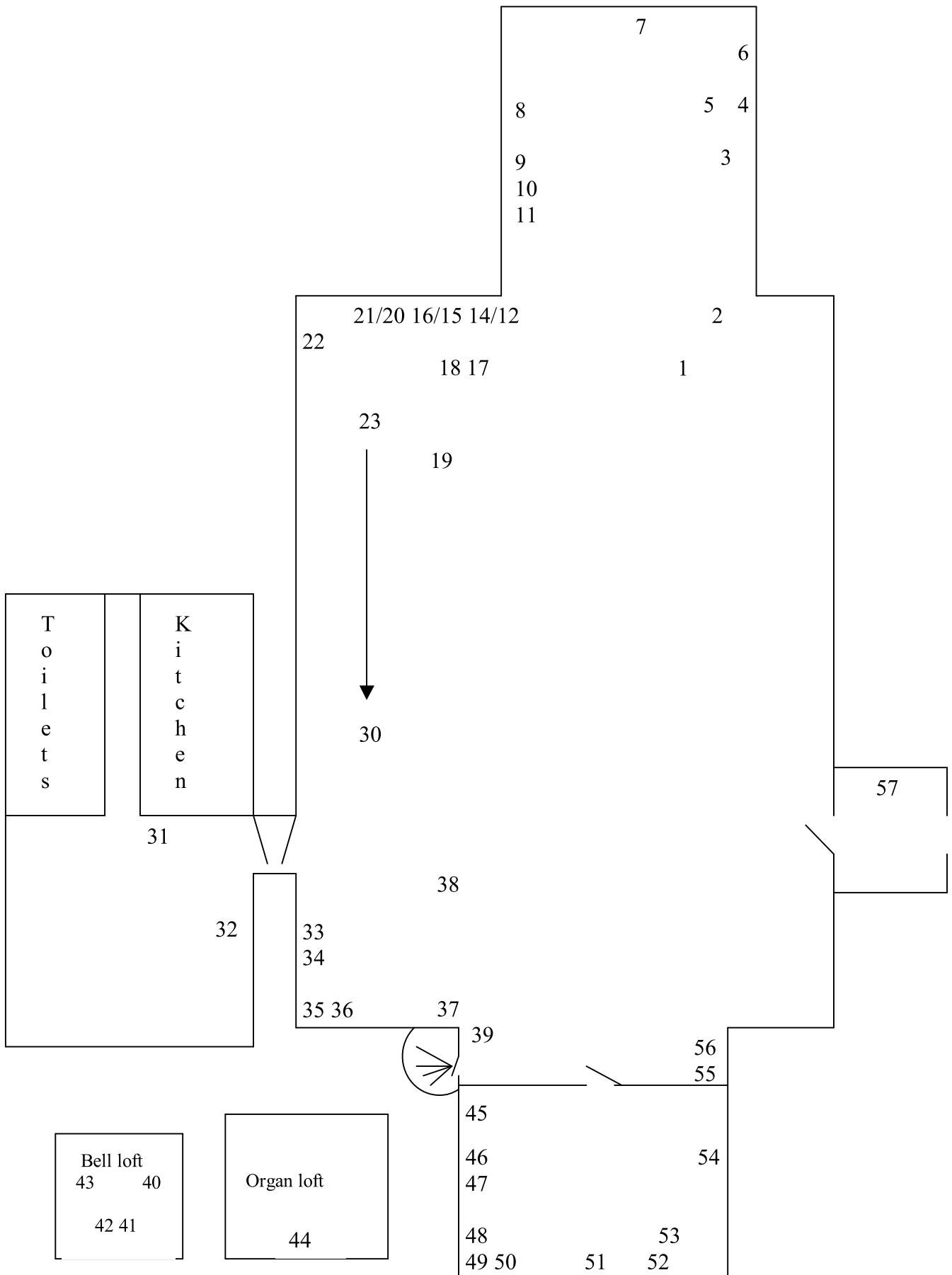
