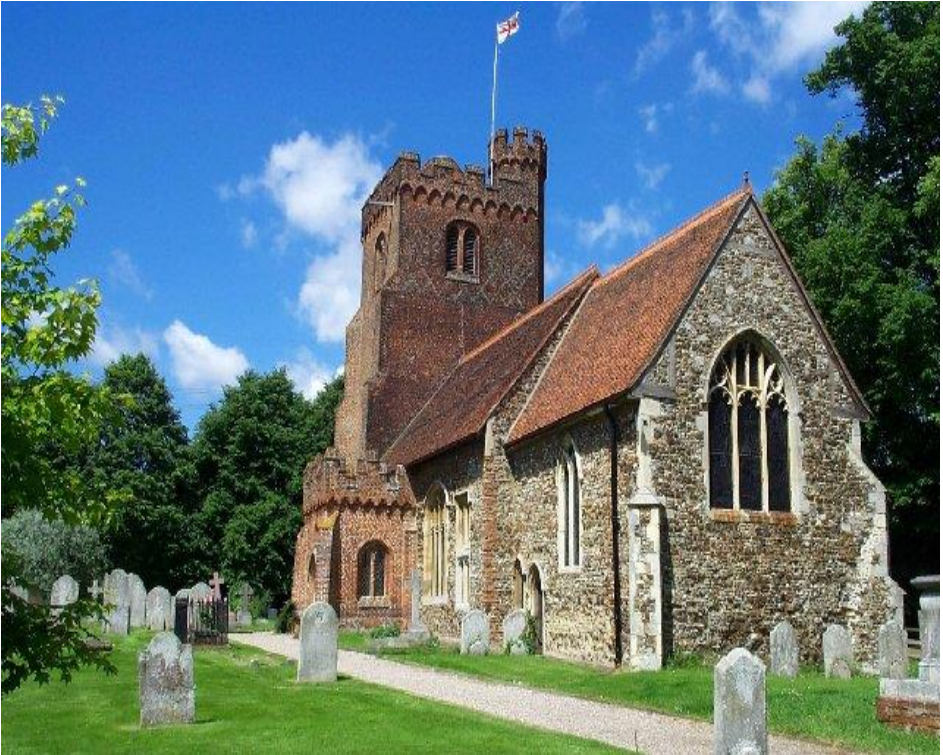


St. Andrew's Sandon
